For the fourth year in a row, Raven's Challenge has brought together military and law enforcement personnel from all over the world for a week of highly specialized training at the Satsop Business Park.

Due to its unique infrastructure and rural setting, the Satsop Business Park is an ideal location for this specialized explosives cross-training event. Participants are able to train in explosives material handling while detonating live explosives in a safe and controlled setting. Raven's Challenge brings together hundreds of participants from regional, State and local bomb

squads, U.S. Armed Services, federal agencies, and international groups of the same categories. The high level training focuses on cross-training the various agencies on bomb disabling, hostage negotiations and various other scenarios that they may encounter in the line of duty.
