

Port of Grays Harbor Terminal 2

Listed below are the typical fees and charges for a vessel calling Port of Grays Harbor Terminal No. 2. The numbers listed below are ESTIMATES only. All amounts are listed in U.S. Dollars.

Port of Grays Harbor charges:

| Pilotage services – inward / outward | \$17,728 | Includes base fee and one shift from anchor @ \$2,330 |
| Pilot Boat Surcharge | \$450 | per each boarding from a boat or helicopter not including inner harbor shifts |
| Shift Assist services – inward/outward | \$14,969 | Base charge includes two tugs |
| Dockage | \$2.20 | per GRT for 1 st 72-hour period; \$0.72 per GRT for each 24-hour period or fraction thereof, following the initial 72-hour dockage period |
| Terminal Security charges | \$990 | per 24-hour period |
| Cement Hatch Attachment Use Fee | | Based on actual labor charges, not to exceed \$20,000 |
| Refusal to use cement hatch attachment | \$12,000 | per 24-hour period, or fraction thereof |
